

SUPERINTENDENT— Gale-Etrick-Trempealeau School District

Start Date: July 1, 2008

Description: 4K-12 enrollment of 1354. The school district operates 5 school buildings: 3 elementary schools, 1 elementary/middle and 1 high school. Staff includes 6 administrators, 115 teachers, and 98 support staff. The annual operating budget totals \$16 million. Visit the district's website at www.getschools.k12.wi.us.

The Gale-Etrick-Trempealeau School District is a consolidated district, comprised of the City of Galesville, and Villages of Etrick and Trempealeau. It is located in the southern-most part of Trempealeau County on Highway 53 approximately twenty minutes from La Crosse. The community of Trempealeau is located along the Mississippi River with Perrot State Park nearby. Each community celebrates an annual event or festival between July and early October. Several wonderful apple orchards surround the area.

Qualifications: Candidates must hold or be eligible for a Wisconsin superintendent's license.
