

District Administrator – Gale-Etrick-Trempealeau School District

Job Description: 4k-12 enrollment of 1400. The school district operates six school buildings: three elementary schools, one middle school, one high school, and an alternative school. Staff includes six administrators, 115 teachers, and 98 support staff. The annual operating budget totals \$16 million. Visit the district's website at www.getschools.k12.wi.us.

The Gale-Etrick-Trempealeau School district is a consolidated district, comprised of the City of Galesville, and Villages of Etrick and Trempealeau. It is located in the southern-most part of Trempealeau County on Highway 53 approximately twenty minutes from La Crosse. The community of Trempealeau is located along the Mississippi River with Perrot State Park nearby. The district opened a new middle school in September and completed remodeling of the Trempealeau Elementary School and the high school. Each community celebrates an annual event or festival between July and early October. The area is known for its many apple orchards.

Qualifications: Candidates must hold or be eligible for a Wisconsin superintendent's license.
