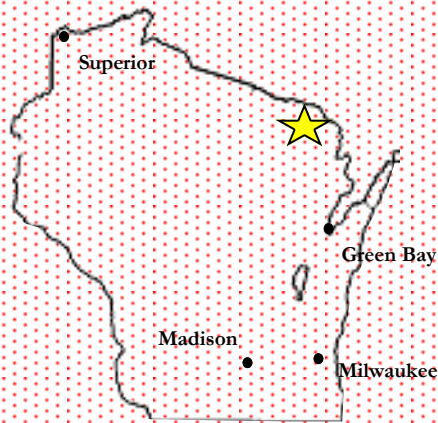

The district is located about 60 miles east of Rhinelander, 80 miles northwest of Green Bay and 180 miles from Milwaukee.
