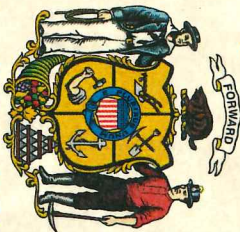

Proclamation

WHEREAS, school boards are important advocates for public education and are responsible for communicating the needs of the school district to the public and the public's expectations to the district;
